HOW IT WORKS -

3.) Check-in at Main Circulation Desk to report book/hour count.

**this is an important step that allows us to keep a GRAND total of books/hours read throughout the summer and ensures we don't miss out on all the reading you're doing!*

4.) Drop tickets in prize can of your choice.

Read and record 10 books, or read and record 10 hours, and get a special invitation to attend Libraries Rock! Finale at the Huron Boat Basin, Thursday, **July 26** at 4:30 pm.

Don't forget that the last day to record books/hours read and to drop off your tickets in the prize cans will be Friday, **July 20** during the Library's hours of operation (9 am to 5 pm).

HURON MAYOR'S SUMMER READING CHALLENGE –

In addition to the awards earned by completing Huron Public Library's Reading Record (10 books or 10 hours), readers may also participate in the Mayor's Challenge of 20 books or 20 hours. Complete the Mayor's Challenge and receive a special certificate and recognition from the Mayor of Huron.
