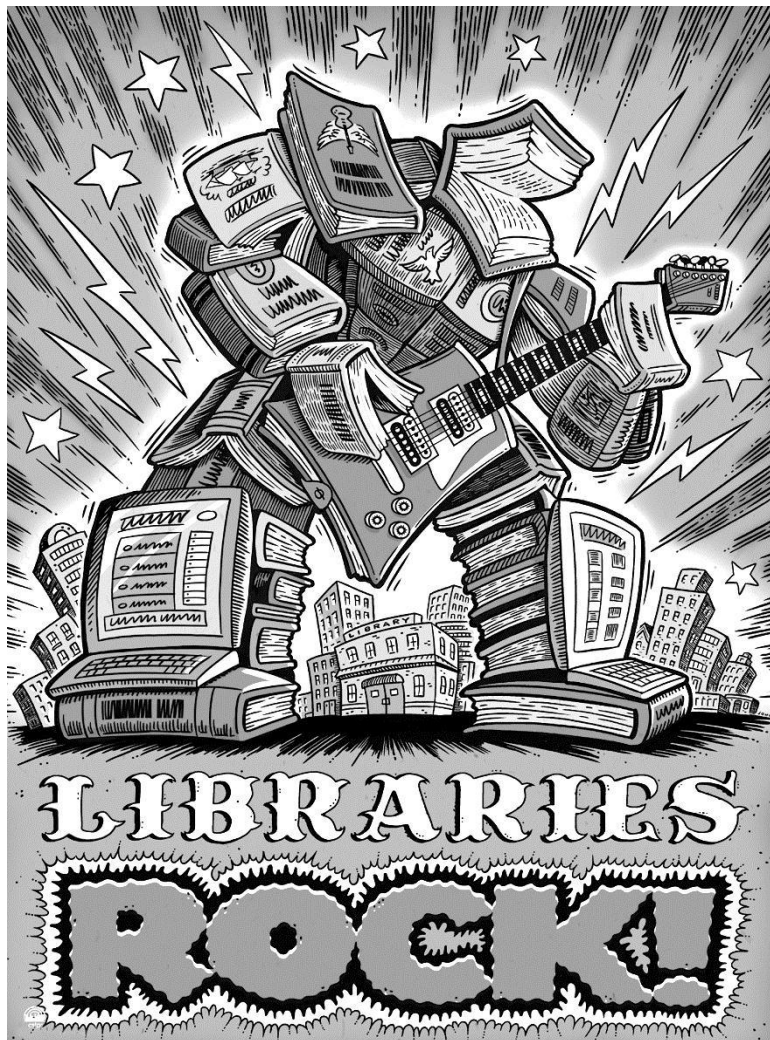

The 2018 Summer Reading Program is fun for everyone, and is a great way to keep up your reading skills through the summer months. It's easy too- here's what you do:

Read at your reading level. As a tween participant, use the TWEEN READING RECORD FORM to **keep track of your reading**. Next, **come upstairs to the Adult Desk** to **get a sticker** for your form and **share your progress** with us so we can keep track of the great reading you are doing. **Fill out an entry ticket** for each book read (or each hour of reading), and **drop it in the prize can** of your choice for a chance to win a weekly prize. *NEW* this year- after choosing the weekly prizewinners, all entries will be put into a drawing for a weekly GRAND prize! The prize cans are located upstairs on the landing by the Geochron World Clock.

Read and record 10 books or 10 hours and receive a special invitation to attend our finale. In addition, the Mayor of Huron has issued a challenge: read 20 books or 20 hours, and receive a special certificate signed by the Mayor! The finale party will take place at the Boat Basin on **Thursday, July 26** at 4:30 pm. It will include music, awards, fun, prizes, and food!

The last day to record books or hours read, and to drop off your tickets in the prize cans, is **Friday, July 20** by 5 pm.
